The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the parties to file a statement comparing the tariffs as originally filed with compliance tariffs under the *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Pensions and Other Post-Employment Benefits*¹ and the *Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement*² ("the stipulations") if approved. The statement shall set forth the monthly increase or monthly decrease, as a dollar amount and as a percentage, for the average residential customer's bill in GMO's two service areas, L&P and MPS.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The filing described in the body of this order is due no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 26, 2016.
