ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE*

On September 12, 2016, Sean R. Brady (“Petitioner”) filed a petition for leave to appear and participate in this matter *pro hac vice* on behalf of Wind on the Wires and The Wind Coalition. In the petition, Petitioner lists the courts of which he is a member in good standing. Petitioner has designated Deirdre K. Hirner as a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar, as local counsel. The petition includes a copy of the receipt from the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court to demonstrate compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m).

The Commission has considered the petition and finds that the request to appear *pro hac vice* complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. Ten days have elapsed from the filing of the petition for leave to appear and no party has objected. Therefore, the Commission will admit Petitioner *pro hac vice* to appear on behalf of Wind on the Wires and The Wind Coalition.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The petition of Sean R. Brady for leave to appear and participate as counsel for Wind on the Wires and The Wind Coalition is granted.
