**ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES**

The Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued notice of complaints filed against Daybreak Ranches, Inc. and Overlook Property Owner's Association in the above-captioned cases. On September 13, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed a *Motion to Consolidate* in each of these cases, which stated that the above cases involve related questions of law and fact and requested that the Commission consolidate the cases to prevent unnecessary costs and delay. More than ten days

have elapsed since the motion was filed and no party has responded or objected to Staff's request.<sup>1</sup> The Commission finds that these actions involve related questions of law and fact and will consolidate these actions pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3).

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. File Nos. WC-2017-0036 and SC-2017-0038 are consolidated. All future case submissions shall be made in File No. WC-2017-0036.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
