**ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT REGARDING  
PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE AWARD**

On September 2, 2016, Ameren Missouri and the Commission's Staff filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement regarding the calculation of Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Performance Incentive Award resulting from Cycle 1 of its Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) programs. The Office of the Public Counsel objected to that stipulation and agreement on September 9. The matter was set for hearing and testimony was prefiled by Ameren Missouri, Staff, and Public Counsel.

On October 24, Ameren Missouri, Staff, and Public Counsel filed a revised stipulation and agreement that modified the calculation of the Performance Incentive Award. Under the original stipulation and agreement, the Performance Incentive Award was calculated to be \$29,065,869.38. Under the revised stipulation and agreement, that Performance Incentive Award will be \$28,246,578.74.

The revised stipulation and agreement was signed only by the filing parties, but no other party objected within seven days of its filing. Therefore, pursuant to Commission rule

4 CSR 240-2.115, the Commission will treat the revised stipulation and agreement as unanimous.

Having considered the revised stipulation and agreement, the Commission determines that it should be approved.

Because there is no remaining controversy among the parties and because this order needs to take effect promptly, the Commission will make this order effective in ten days.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Revised Stipulation and Agreement Addressing Ameren Missouri's Performance Incentive Award filed on October 24, 2016, is approved.
2. The signatories to the Stipulation and Agreement shall comply with the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement.
3. The Stipulation and Agreement is incorporated into this order, and is attached as Attachment A.
4. This order shall become effective on November 12, 2016.
