On December 1, 2016, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application requesting a modification of its existing variance from the Commission's rule that establishes gas meter testing procedures. The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding that application on March 22, 2017. Staff recommends the Commission approve the application, but would impose certain conditions on that approval.

The Commission will establish a time to respond to Staff's recommendation.
