## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: July 17, 2017 Effective Date: July 17, 2017

Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) filed an application requesting an Accounting Authority Order to track and record as a regulatory asset certain property tax payments between years 2016 and 2017. The Commission issued an order setting a July 14, 2017 deadline for the filing of applications to intervene. On July 6, 2017, Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed separate applications to intervene. Since more than ten days have passed and no responses were filed, the Commission will consider the unopposed applications to intervene.

The Commission finds that both MECG and MIEC have an interest in this matter that differs from those of the general public and that those interests may be adversely impacted by a final order in this matter. The Commission also finds that allowing MECG and MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Midwest Energy Consumers Group's Application to Intervene is granted.
- 2. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' Application to Intervene is granted.
