On July 18, 2017, 188 North Summit, LLC and Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC ("Applicants") filed a joint application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking authority for 188 North Summit, LLC to purchase substantially all of the water and sewer assets of Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC. Applicants also request certificates of convenience and necessity for 188 North Summit, LLC and waivers from certain Commission administrative rules.

Section 393.190.1, RSMo 2016, requires that when transactions such as the one described in the application are submitted to the Commission for approval, the Commission must send notice "to the county clerk of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located." Since the application states that the water and sewer facilities being sold are located in Callaway County, the Commission will direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to the

county clerk and county commission of Callaway County, Missouri. The Commission will also establish deadlines for persons wishing to intervene and a preliminary response from its Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the county clerk and county commission of Callaway County, Missouri.
- 2. Any interested person wishing to intervene in this case shall file an application to intervene no later than August 16, 2017.
- 3. No later than August 16, 2017, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating when it anticipates filing its recommendation in this matter.
 - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
