On August 28, 2017, North American Telecommunications Corporation's ("North American") notified the Commission that the company no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri. The Commission granted North American its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri in File No. DA-2015-0228.

On August 29, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing parties to file an objection or request a hearing no later than September 18, 2017. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

On September 12, 2017, Staff filed a motion to cancel North American's registration as an IVoIP provider.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on North American's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to North American Telecommunications Corporation, shall be canceled.
