**ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On June 11, 2018, Claude Scott filed a formal complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”). At Ameren Missouri’s request, the parties attempted mediation. Mediation complete and the complaint unresolved, the Commission now must determine how to proceed.

To assist in that determination, the Commission will schedule a prehearing conference at which the parties may discuss the establishment of a procedural schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference to be held on September 20, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. Failure to appear at the conference without being excused may result in a default being issued in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090(5).

2. The prehearing conference will convene in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. The building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the conference or hearing shall contact the Commission, not later than the day before the conference. Such contact shall be through the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711. Any party may participate in the prehearing conference by telephone by dialing (573) 526-5402 or (866) 630-9346 at the start time of the conference.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
