## NOTICE OF WORKSHOP

The Commission opened this file on July 11, 2018, at the request of Commission's Staff, to assist Staff in its consideration of a new rule regarding the treatment of customer information by Commission-regulated electric, gas, steam heating, water and sewer utilities. The scope of the case was subsequently expanded to include matters relating to utility use of Advanced Meter Infrastructure (AMI) or smart meters. Several interested stakeholders filed written comments for Staff's consideration. On September 4, Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to notify interested stakeholders of a workshop to further discuss these matters.

The workshop will take place on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, at the Commission's Office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison St., Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, Conference Room 470, beginning at 1:00 p.m., and ending at approximately 4:00 p.m. The meeting will be open to the public, except for any discussion of confidential information.

Staff asks that entities or persons planning to attend the workshop tell Staff counsel by September 20 what they think should be on the agenda for the workshop and whether they would be willing to make a presentation on a topic they think should be on the agenda.
