ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS AND CLOSING FILE

This case concerns Spire Missouri, Inc.'s application for authority to sell a section of natural gas pipeline to an affiliated company, Spire STL Pipeline, LLC. At Spire Missouri's request, the Commission stayed these proceedings indefinitely to allow Spire STL Pipeline to decide whether it still wants to purchase the pipeline from Spire Missouri. That decision depended on an anticipated decision by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to approve an alternative route for the proposed pipeline that will not require Spire STL Pipeline to purchase a section of Spire Missouri's pipeline.

Spire Missouri filed a status report on September 17, 2018, indicating the FERC has made a decision to grant Spire STL Pipeline's application. As a result, Spire Missouri no longer seeks to sell a portion of its pipeline to Spire STL Pipeline and asks the Commission to dismiss its application. The Commission will do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Spire Missouri, Inc.'s motion to dismiss its application is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.

3. This file shall be closed.
