ORDER APPOINTING MEDIATOR

On March 8, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Adopting Procedural Schedule* (“Procedural Schedule”). The *Procedural Schedule* set the case for an evidentiary hearing to commence on June 3, 2019, and to continue on June 4, 2019, if necessary. On May 21, 2019, Missouri-American Water Company filed a *Motion to Refer Complaint to Mediation*, stating therein that the parties had agreed to engage in mediation, requesting that the evidentiary hearing be cancelled, and requesting that the case be scheduled for mediation. The Commission suspended the *Procedural Schedule* and cancelled the evidentiary hearing. The Commission will now appoint a mediator as allowed in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.125(2).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Charles Hatcher, Regulator Law Judge, is appointed as mediator.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
