**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On April 12, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application asking the Commission to cancel the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted to Ameren Missouri in 2005 applicable to the property formerly occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Noranda and now occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Magnitude 7 Metals, LLC. Ameren Missouri also asked the Commission to cancel its Large Transmission Service (LTS) rate schedule under which Noranda was the only qualifying customer.

In response to Ameren Missouri's filing, the Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding the application by June 12. Meanwhile, on June 5, Public Counsel, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed a motion asking the Commission to schedule a hearing regarding Ameren Missouri's request.

On June 10, Staff filed a request for additional time to file its recommendation, explaining it seeks more time so that its recommendation can be filed on June 17, the date responses are due regarding the motion for hearing. Staff says the requested extension will allow it to file a single comprehensive, coherent, and non-repetitive response to all aspects of this case.

The Commission will grant Staff's request for an extension.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's application no later than June 17, 2019.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
