ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 29, 2019, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Confluence Rivers”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to acquire, own, install, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system in Perry County, Missouri. The requested Certificate of Convenience and Necessity would allow Confluence Rivers to acquire the assets and CCN of Port Perry Service Company.

Staff filed its recommendation on May 31. Lake Perry Lot Owners’ Association, an intervening party, filed its response on June 4, disagreeing with Staff’s recommendation, requesting a hearing, and renewing its motion to dismiss. The Office of Public Counsel filed its response to Staff’s recommendation on June 10, and also requests a hearing and the addition of Port Perry Service Company as a party.

In order to discuss a procedural schedule, the Commission will set a prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall appear at a prehearing conference to be held on June 28, 2019, at 10:00 a.m.
2. The prehearing conference will convene in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. The building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the conference or hearing shall contact the Commission, not later than the day before the conference. 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
