ORDER CANCELING PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

On June 25, 2020, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate to provide payphone service granted to the predecessor of Coyote Call, Inc. in File No. TA-95-169, on January 27, 1995.

Staff states in its motion that Coyote Call sent an e-mail to Staff on June 24, 2020, indicating its desire to relinquish its certificate. Staff indicates Coyote Call's request to cancel its Registration is in compliance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3), and asks the Commission to cancel that Registration.

On June 25, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Establishing Time to Respond* allowing parties until July 6, 2020, to object or to request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on the company's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate granted to Coyote Call shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The certificate to provide payphone services granted to Coyote Call,
 Inc., in File Number TA-95-169, is canceled.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on August 6, 2020.
 - 3. This file may be closed on August 7, 2020.
