Dear Mr. Kerr:

On behalf of the Missouri Public Service Commission, I am pleased to forward our annual report on developments resulting from the implementation of the 2007 Video Service Providers Act. As provided in Section 67.269 RSMo., the Commission is required to submit its findings to the General Assembly by August 28, 2010.

This year, the Commission identified thirty providers offering video service through 799 state-issued video authorizations as of June 1, 2010. These authorizations correspond to 519 distinct political subdivisions or 50% of all political subdivisions in Missouri. By August 27, 2010, companies will have initiated video service for 634 authorizations, while 165 state-issued video authorizations will not have video service implemented by this date. Please be aware that this data is drawn from survey responses and may not be all-inclusive.

Further details on the Commission's study methods and other related issues are provided in the report. I hope you find this information useful. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
